## Terms and conditions 2020

- 1** The award shall be granted to a researcher with a noteworthy curriculum in the field of biomedical research and health science.
- 2** The candidates must comply with the following cumulative requirements: researchers must be aged under 42 (as at 31 December 2019), of any nationality and must have fulfilled a minimum of three continuous years of research work in Spain, and have centered their work in the field of biomedicine and health sciences. This age may be extended up to a maximum of one year for each child when the candidate has experienced breaks in their professional career for maternity leave.
- 3** Candidates must be recommended by persons affiliated with universities, hospitals or research centres.
- 4** The proposals must be prepared in Spanish or in English, between 15 January 2020 - 30 March 2020 (both inclusive) online via the website [www.fundacionbancosabadell.com](http://www.fundacionbancosabadell.com) (Grants & Awards, Prizes).
- 5** Each proposal must include:
  - A cover letter of the person who is recommending the candidate, in PDF format.
  - The candidate's curriculum, in PDF format, in a maximum of 5 pages.
  - A single document in PDF format which includes (i) a list of all of the most relevant research reports carried out (maximum 10) and (ii) a copy of the documents listed above.
- 6** The panel of judges shall be chaired by Dr Oscar Marín and the judges shall be selected from amongst different researchers, all of whom are specialists in biomedicine. The judges' verdict is final, and it shall be made public in June 2020. The award winner shall attend the award ceremony and announcement to the press (lunch with the press and members of the panel of judges).
- 7** The nomination of candidates implies full acceptance of these terms and conditions.
